



## East Village Association, Inc. Regular and Associate Member Program

**Brief Overview:** The East Village Association, Inc. was established in 2009 as a nonprofit organization to primarily:

- Be an advocate for businesses in East Village
- Promote East Village as a desirable destination to live, play, and work
- Beautify and improve the quality of life for residents and businesses in East Village
- Provide more safety and other services to the neighborhood
- Monitor and protect East Village interests

### **Membership Categories:**

*Regular members*\* in good standing are businesses or representatives of businesses within the specified East Village Business Improvement District (BID) boundary who have paid the City of San Diego's Business License Tax and BID's annual assessment. *Regular members* may also be residents or property owners in East Village within the specified East Village Business Improvement District (BID) boundary and who have paid the \$100 annual membership dues.

*Associate members* in good standing are individuals or businesses who have an interest in East Village, who have paid the required annual membership dues and who are approved by the East Village Association, Inc. Board of Directors.

Regular, and associate members are eligible to vote in the annual election, may serve on committees and may serve on the Board of Directors.

\*Exempt from City of San Diego's Business Tax License and BID annual assessment are nonprofit public benefit corporations, nonprofit religious organizations, individual taxicab business license holders and individual pedicab business license holders and those certain business license holders who are a part of the San Diego City College Technology Incubator program.

Note: Annual membership dues are nonrefundable. Nonprofit organizations may apply to be considered for associate membership; subject to Board of Directors' approval.
